<u>Contract Approval</u>: This procurement is subject to approval by the HCC Board of Trustees. Subsequent to Board approval, the <u>only</u> person authorized to commit HCC contractually is the Chancellor or his designee.

Project Overview:

The Houston Community College System ("HCC") is seeking proposals from qualified firms to provide On-Site Full Service Travel Management Services to Houston Community College. The Contractor will be required to maintain an on-site location in the System Administration Services Building located at 3100 Main Street, Houston, TX 77002. Office space will be provided by HCC at no cost to the Contractor during the term of the resulting contract.

<u>Contract Term:</u> The contract term for contract(s) awarded resulting from this solicitation will be one (1) year with four (4) one-year renewal options.

<u>Pre-Proposal Conference:</u> A pre-proposal conference will be held in the Purchasing Department, 3100 Main Street (11th Floor) Houston, Texas 77002 on April 11, 2006 at 2:00 p.m. (local time).

<u>Proposal Due Date/Time:</u> HCC will accept proposals to provide the required Full Service Travel Management Services until 4:00 p.m. (local time) on April 19, 2006. Proposals will be received in the Purchasing Department, 3100 South Main Street (11th Floor, Room #11A06), Houston, Texas 77002 between the hours of 8:30 a.m. and 4:30 p.m., Monday through Friday.

HCC is an equal opportunity/educational institution, which does not discriminate on the basis of race, color, religion, national origin, gender, age or disability.

HCC reserves the right to accept or reject all or any part of any proposal, waive minor informalities and award contracts to best serve its interest

This Request for Proposal does not obligate HCC to award a contract or to pay any costs incurred by a proposer in the preparation or submission of a proposal.

INSTRUCTIONS TO PROPOSERS

1. Introduction

HCC is seeking proposals under the negotiated method of procurement from qualified firms interested in providing On-Site Full Service Travel Management Services in accordance with the Scope of Services contained in this solicitation (Attachment No. 3).

2. Background

HCC has an annual operating budge in excess of \$200,000,000. It employs approximately 1,700 full time employees and 3,400 part time employees on an annual basis. The college is currently comprised of six regional colleges with more than 45 operational sites, and the system's administration offices. The college serves approximately 54,000 students per semester. HCC's spending for travel expenses for the past year (2004-2005) was \$919,200.00.

2. **Proposal Submittal**

3. Eligibility for Award

- a. In order for a proposer to be eligible to be awarded the contract, the proposal must be responsive to the solicitation and HCC must be able to determine that the proposer is responsible and has the resources and capacity to perform the resulting contract satisfactorily.
- b. Responsive proposals are those complying in all material aspects of the solicitation. Proposals, which do not comply with all the terms and, conditions of this solicitation will be rejected as non-responsive.
- c. Responsible proposers as a minimum must:
 - Have adequate financial resources, or the ability to obtain such resources as required during the performance of the contract.
 - Be able to comply with the required performance schedule, taking into consideration all existing business commitments.
 - Have a satisfactory record of past performance.
 - Have necessary personnel and management capability to perform the contract.
 - Be qualified as an established firm regularly engaged in the type of business necessary to fulfill the contract requirements.
 - Certify that the firm is not delinquent in any tax owed the State of Texas under Chapter 171, Tax Code; signing and submitting the proposal is so certifying.
 - Be otherwise qualified and eligible to receive an award under applicable laws and regulations.

Proposer(s) may be requested to submit additional written evidence verifying that the firm meets the minimum criteria necessary to perform the requirements of the solicitation and be determined a responsible proposer. Failure to provide any requested additional information may result in the proposer being declared non-responsive, and the proposal being rejected.

4. Preparation of Proposal

A. Technical and Price Proposal:

The technical proposal shall include, as a minimum, the following information:

- <u>Cover letter</u>: The cover letter shall not to exceed 2 pages in length, summarizing key points in the proposal.
- <u>Project Management and Services</u>: This section shall include the management and technical approach to performing the services in accordance with the attached Scope of Services (pgs. 11-14).
- Qualifications and Experience of Firm: This section shall include a description of the firm, including firm's history, size and professional staff composition. Include a description of the firm's past and current contracts/assignments, which are related to the type of services, required by this solicitation.

- Qualifications and Experience of Personnel: This section shall include a project-staffing plan including resumes for all proposed "key" staff members who will be assigned to this project. If personnel substitutions are contemplated on a contingency basis, they should also be identified. Provide an organizational chart, which includes "key" staff members and their respective responsibilities for this project. Provide a detailed management plan with defined lines of authority and proposer's commitment to utilize HCC students in an internship capacity.
- <u>Small Business Participation:</u> This section shall include a clear statement of the firm's commitment and plan to meet the small business goal specified in this solicitation.
- <u>Business Data/Financial Statement:</u> This section shall include financial statements (last three years) of the company.
- <u>Price Proposal:</u> The price proposal shall be clearly identified as a "price proposal" within the technical proposal. (See Attachment No. 2, Schedule of Items and Prices).

5. Evaluation Criteria

An Evaluation Committee ("Committee") will review all proposals to determine which proposers have qualified for consideration according to the criteria stated herein. The committee's evaluations will be based on all available information, including qualification statements, subsequent interviews, if necessary, reports, discussions, reference checks, and other appropriate checks. The highest rated proposers evaluated by the Committee may be invited to make an oral presentation of their written proposal to the Committee and/or the HCC Board of Trustees. Proposals will be evaluated using the following criteria:

6. Contract Award

Award will be made to the responsive, responsible proposer whose proposal conforms to this solicitation and offers the best value to HCC, price and other factors considered. HCC may award a contract, based on initial proposals received, without discussion of such proposals. Accordingly, each initial proposal should be submitted on the most favorable terms from a price and technical standpoint, which the proposer can submit to HCC.

7. Postponement of Proposals Due Date/Time

Notwithstanding the date/time for receipt of proposals established in this solicitation, the date and time established herein for receiving proposals may be postponed solely at HCC's discretion.

8. Oral Presentations

During the process of selecting a company to provide the required services, oral presentations may or may not be held. Each proposer should be prepared to make a presentation to HCC. The presentations must show that the proposer clearly understands the requirements of the solicitation, and has a strategic plan and approach to complete the work.

9. Small Business Development Program (SBDP)

- A. HCC has adopted a Small Business Development Program for small businesses attempting to provide goods and/or services as prime contractors or as subcontractors to other prime contractors to HCC. The program is designed to prevent discrimination by ensuring that small, underutilized and disadvantaged businesses are informed and prepared to compete for HCC procurements. HCC will neither discriminate nor select vendors on the basis of race, color, national origin, religion, gender, age or disability in its procurement selection process.
- B. Small businesses whose gross annual income averaged over the past three (3) years does not exceed the Small Business Administration's size standard as specified in 13 CFR Part 121 are eligible to apply for participation in the program.
- C. For this solicitation, HCC has established (35) percent of the total amount of the proposal as its goal for Small Business participation.
- D. Good Faith Efforts: HCC will make a good faith effort to utilize small businesses in all contracts. The annual program goals may be met by contracting directly with small businesses or indirectly through subcontracting opportunities. Therefore, any business that contracts with HCC will be required to make a good faith effort to award subcontracts to small businesses. The subcontracting goal applies to all vendors regardless of their status By implementing the following procedures, a contractor shall be presumed to have made a good faith effort:
- To the extent consistent with industry practices, divide the contract work into reasonable lots.
- Give notice to SBDP eligible firms of subcontract opportunities or post notices of such opportunities in newspapers and other circulars.
- Document reasons for rejecting a firm that bids on subcontracting opportunities.

10. Small Business Compliance

A. To ensure compliance with any stated small business participation goal, the selected vendor/contractor will be required to meet with the HCC Buyer and a representative of the Economic Development Office at the 50% and 75% completion phases/dates of the project, to verify small business participation activity and to ensure compliance with the stated small business goal, if any.

11. Internship Program

HCC is expanding its student internship program. All vendors are encouraged to make a commitment to utilize certain HCC student(s) in an internship capacity with the company under any resulting contract for services required under this solicitation. The selected contractor will be expected to pay the student(s) at least the minimum wage required by law. HCC will provide the selected contractor with the name of student(s) eligible to participate in the internship program.

12. **Prohibited Communications**

Except as provided in exceptions below, the following communications regarding a particular invitation for bids, requests for proposal, requests for qualifications, or other solicitation are prohibited:

- [1] Between a potential vendor, service provider, bidder, offeror, lobbyist or consultant and any Trustee;
- [2] Between any Trustee and any member of a selection or evaluation committee; and
- [3] Between any Trustee and administrator or employee.

The communications prohibition shall be imposed on the date that responses to the solicitation are due or received, whichever is first.

The communications prohibition shall terminate when:

- [1] The contract is awarded by the Chancellor or his designee; or
- [2] The award recommendations are considered by the Board at a duly-noticed public meeting.

In the event the Board refers the recommendation back to staff for reconsideration, the communications prohibition shall be re-imposed.

The communications prohibition shall not apply to the following:

- [1] Duly noted pre-bid or pre-proposal conferences.
- [2] Communications with the HCC General Counsel.
- [3] Emergency contracts.
- [4] Presentations made to the Board during any duly-noticed public meeting.
- [5] Unless otherwise prohibited in the solicitation documents, any written communications between any parties, provided that the originator shall immediately file a copy of any written communication with the Board Services Office. The Board Services Office shall make copies available to any person upon request.
- [6] Nothing contained herein shall prohibit any person or entity from publicly addressing the Board during any duly-noticed public meeting, in accordance with applicable Board policies, regarding action on the contract.

11. **Drug Policy**

HCC is a drug-free workforce and workplace. The manufacture, sale, distribution, dispensation, or use of illegal drugs or alcohol by vendors or contractors while on HCC's premises is strictly prohibited.

SCOPE OF SERVICES

FOR

ON-SITE FULL SERVICE TRAVEL MANAGEMENT SERVICES

I. SCOPE

This scope of service covers the requirements for the Contractor to furnish all supervision, labor, equipment, materials and transportation necessary and required to provide Full Service Travel Management Services to Houston Community College on an "as needed" basis. The Contractor shall maintain an on-site office in the System Administration Building at 3100 Main Street, Houston, TX 77002.

II. <u>SERVICE REQUIREMENTS:</u>

A. <u>Transportation</u>

- 1. The Contractor shall provide domestic and/or international airline and railway tickets at the lowest fare available within the arrival/departure times and locations specified by the requesting traveler or representative of HCC. If an arrival/departure time is not specified, the Contractor shall provide a list (orally or in writing) of available air or rail and corresponding lowest fares for selection by the traveler, including on-line ticketing opportunities.
- 2. The Contractor shall provide advance seat assignment.

B. Lodging:

The Contractor shall arrange hotel/motel accommodations when requested, taking advantage of educational, governmental or corporate discounts, whichever is greater. If a specific hotel/motel is not requested, the location of the lodging should be reasonably close to the required destination. Contractor to offer negotiated or consortium rates whenever available.

C. Vehicle Rental:

The Contractor shall arrange vehicle rentals, when requested, at the lowest rate available. The rates should be confirmed when the reservation is made and included on the traveler's itinerary. College shall have option to waive collision damage insurance and other insurance cost in each rental. All such cost shall be borne by HCC's automobile insurance coverage/policy.

D. International Travel:

- 1. The Contractor shall arrange for international travel, including reservations and ticket delivery, for air, rail, bus, or ship transportation, and when requested, for hotel/motel accommodations and for car rentals.
- 2. The Contractor shall provide assistance in obtaining passports, visas and documents regarding health requirements.
- 3. The Contractor shall work with HCC's Risk Management Department policies on international travel.

E. Seminars and Meetings:

The Contractor may arrange group conference accommodations, when requested, taking advantage of available discounts. Arrangements may include, but are not limited to, the reservation of meeting or classroom space, lodging, meals, transportation to meeting site and all other related functions. HCC may elect to make direct arrangements on a case-by-case basis.

F. Traveler's Itineraries:

- 1. The Contractor shall provide two (2) copies (via E-mail) to the traveler including the following information:
 - a. Name of Carrier(s)
 - b. Flight, train, bus or voyage numbers and departure and arrival times for each segment of the trip.
 - c. Ground transportation facilities at destination (e.g. taxis/shuttle service).
 - d. Meals provided indicate whether or not meals are provided.
 - e. Name, phone number and location or hotel/motel and room rates.
 - f. Name and location of car rental agency and rates.
- 2. The Contractor shall maintain a database of employee travel preferences (i.e. seating assignments, frequent flyer numbers, etc.)

G. Contractor Assistance:

The Contractor shall provide assistance, training, and orientation to designated travel coordinators upon the request of HCC.

H. Refunds:

- 1. The Contractor shall provide any refunds due as a result of unused tickets and shall identify each refund by original ticket and/or invoice number.
- 2. Refunds shall be credited to HCC in whatever form of payment the original purchase was made.

I. Cancellation:

1. The Contractor shall provide support for cancellation in which purchased ticket will be credited to HCC account.

J. Hours of Operation:

The Contractor shall provide at least eight hours of service daily compatible with HCC working hours, (8:00 A.M. – 5:00 P.M.) Monday through Friday. Emergency services require outside working hours shall be provided by the

K. Schedule Changes, Cancellations and Delays:

- a. The Contractor shall make every effort to notify travelers of airport closings, cancelled or delayed flights, trains, buses or voyages.
- b. The Contractor shall provide alternate travel arrangements whenever a carrier defaults or cancels a scheduled departure.

L. Common Carrier and Flight Insurance:

The Contractor should provide free automatic common carrier and flight Insurance for all air and rail travelers.

M. Reporting Requirements:

The Contractor shall provide (for airline travel only) a detailed monthly management report for airline travel.

This report shall contain a minimum of the following information:

- 1. Name of traveler
- 2. Date of ticket
- 3. Ticket number or other transaction identification number
- 4. Travel (departure and destination information)
- 5. Actual fare
- 6. Regular coach fare (as of date of booking)
- 7. Discount Fare
- 8. All monthly reports submitted by the Contractor shall reference HCC's budget requirements as follows:
 - a. Account/Sub Account (always 5 digits)
 - b. Fund Code (always 4 digits)
 - c. Department Code (always 4 digits
 - d. Program Code (always 3 digits)
 - e. Class Code (always 3 digits)

This information will be provided by to the selected Contractor by HCC.

III. GENERAL REQUIREMENTS:

- 1. The Contractor and its authorized representatives shall meet periodically with HCC's travel services staff, when requested, to discuss all services provided under the requirements of the contract.
- 2. The Contractor shall provide tickets/reservations for air, rail, hotel, and/or vehicle rental accommodations within 24 hours of the request by HCC, or at a specific future date as requested.
- 3. The Contractor shall be required to monitor fares within not more than three (3) days prior to the date and time of departure. If a lower rate should become available, the Contractor shall be responsible for the re-issuance and delivery of new tickets to the traveler, internet pricing should be included.
- 4. The Contractor shall refund to HCC the difference in cost if it has failed to secure the lowest available rate for any services within the scope of the contract, unless the lowest available rate was refused by the traveler and is included in the Rejection of Lowest Available Fare Report.
- 5. The Contractor shall provide travel cost estimates, for budget planning, to individuals for specific trips, conferences or other potential service requirements.
- 6. The Contractor shall provide Executive/VIP treatment to HCC' executive officers and members of the Board of Trustees. HCC will provide the Contractor with the names and titles of these individuals.
- 7. The Contractor and HCC's designated representative(s) may mutually establish routine travel procedures, for handling the travel service requirements of HCC.
- 8. The Contractor shall ensure bonus awards for frequent flyers, etc.

1. Contract Award

A response to the solicitation is an offer to contract with the Houston Community College System ("HCC") based on the terms and conditions contained therein. Proposals do not become contracts until they are accepted by HCC through issuance of written purchase orders or other duly executed documents.

2. Contract Term

The Contract performance period shall be one (1) year with four (4) one-year renewal options, unless otherwise extended or terminated by HCC in accordance with the terms and conditions of this contract. Renewal options are subject to prior approval by the Board of Trustees.

3. Interpretation, Jurisdiction and Venue

The contract shall be construed and interpreted solely in accordance with the laws of the State of Texas. Venue of any suit, right or cause of action arising under or in connection with the contract shall be exclusively in Harris County, Texas.

4. Compliance with Laws

The Contractor shall give all notices and comply with all Federal, State of Texas and local laws. Upon request, the Contractor shall furnish to HCC certificates of compliance with all such laws.

5. Taxes

HCC is tax exempt as a governmental subdivision of the State of Texas under Section 501C (3) of the Internal Revenue Code. Limited Sales Tax No.: 1-74-1709152-1.

6. Termination for Convenience

HCC may, at its option and discretion, terminate or reduce the statement of work or other requirements of the contract at any time, without any default on the part of the Contractor, by giving thirty (30) calendar days written notice thereof to the Contractor.

7. Termination for Default

HCC may terminate the contract immediately for default, by giving written notice thereof to the Contractor, if the contractor neglects to execute the work properly; performs in an unsatisfactory manner or fails to perform any provisions of the contract. In the event of termination for default, HCC shall have against the Contractor, all remedies provided by law and equity.

8. Ethics Conduct

Any direct or indirect actions taken to unduly influence competitive purposes, to circumvent equal consideration for competitive bidders, or to disregard ethical and legal trade practices will disqualify vendors and contractors from current and future consideration for participation in HCC orders and contracts.

9. Small Business Development Program (SBDP)

The Contractor hereby agrees to attain small business participation in the amount of ______% of the total contract amount. The Contractor agrees to enter into agreements for the Work identified in Attachment No. 7, entitled Contractor and First Tier Subcontractor/Supplier Participation. The subcontracting goal applies to all vendors regardless of their status. The Contractor's failure to comply with the aforementioned small business participation provisions may result in:
